Family Details

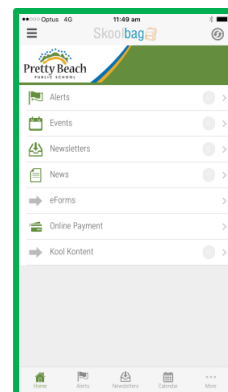

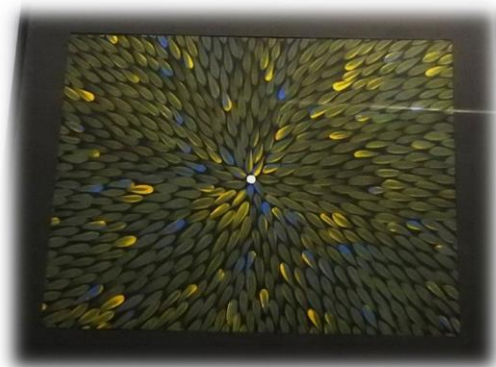
